



### Total number of medical doctors increasing

The total number of registered physicians in Finland on 31 December 2018 was 30,272. Of these physicians, 27,264 were resident in Finland and 21,148 were formally of working age (under 65 years of age). There are 261 inhabitants per medical doctor of working age in our country. Physicians in other European Union countries also obtain licensing from Finland. Not all of them apply to work in Finland, so the labour force of medical doctors in Finland is smaller than the actual number of licensed physicians.

## Physicians of working age: 59% specialized

After graduating as a physician, it is possible to specialize in as many as 50 fields. In Finland, there are 12,543 specialists of working age who hold 15,030 specialist licences. The largest specialization is general practice, and the smallest is oral and maxillofacial surgery.
